Subject: NSPCC Fundraising Challenge

Dear Parents/Carers,

In assembly yesterday Helen from the NSPCC talked to the children about the work of her charity. Childline aims to answer over half a million calls from children and young people who need someone to turn to and the NSPCC helpline provides advice and support to thousands of adults who think that a child may be in danger or distress.

The NSPCC would like your help to make sure that every child receives the help they need. They hope that the children of St Mark's can make a difference by taking part in a sponsored activity **completed out of school** in the next two weeks. The activity is a **Physical Challenge** with sponsors donating upon completion of whatever challenge a child may choose to do e.g Bike ride, Dancing, Football skills, Running, Swimming etc

Unfortunately yesterday, due to an unforeseen error, some children were incorrectly given a Spelling Challenge sponsor form and activity pack by the NSPCC. Could we ask you return the Spelling Challenge sponsor forms to school if you haven't written on them already. We will send home the Physical Challenge sponsor form and activity packs the NSPCC are now delivering before we break up on Friday.

If your child chooses to try and make a difference and complete a sponsored Physical Challenge could we ask you please ensure that both the form and sponsor money are returned to school by **Tuesday 7th March**. If you are sending in sponsor money by cheque, please make the cheque payable to "NSPCC Registered Charity".

You may be aware that charities are able to claim Gift Aid on contributions from UK tax payers. The sponsor form should be completed giving the sponsor's full name and address, including the post code, and a tick put in the UK tax payer box.
