Intervention	Rationale	Object/impact
Staffing resource	Teaching assistants to support and deliver intervention programmes in school.	To ensure children make 'expected' progress in all subjects. Enabling Disadvantaged pupils to attain the same or better than their peers in school and nationally. To make sure pupils achieve their targets.
After school activities	To subsidise the cost of children to attend after school clubs and activities.	To enable children to take part in a range of enrichment and physical activities. To facilitate a more positive attitude towards school resulting in a positive effect on learning and outcomes in the classroom.
Music tuition and educational visits	Funding provided for children to attend musical instrument sessions and contribution towards educational visits and trips.	To enhance curriculum opportunities for children and ensure all children can access the learning and opportunities offered.
Breakfast and after school club.	To provide financial assistance for pupils to attend breakfast & after school club.	To provide support and ensure a smooth transition at the start and end of the school day.
