A New Vocabulary!

- Phonics – the learning of letters and sounds
- Phoneme – the sound a letter makes
- Grapheme – the written letter
- Blending – running sounds together to make a word
- Segmenting – breaking a word up into its component sounds
- Tricky words – words that cannot be decoded using phonics
- *cvc* – c = consonant (b/c/d/f), v = vowel (a/e/ee)
- Digraph - a sound made with two letters eg. sh ai oi
- Phonetically plausible – written phonetically that it can still be read although it is spelt incorrectly eg. torl werk cabij
