Dear Parents/Carers

Our topic this term is The Industrial Revolution, and as part of this, we will study the development of mills in Manchester in history .

To enhance the children's learning we have arranged a trip to Quarry Bank Mill on Tuesday 17th October. The children will have a guided session in the apprentice house and a tour of the mill. We will hopefully also walk to Styal village to look at the workers houses and what village life was like.

To cover the cost of admission and transport, we are asking for a contribution of £14.51 per child. Payment can be made before 26th September via your ParentPay account (www.parentpay.com). Parental consent for your child to attend the trip will also be required and this can be given by ticking the appropriate box on ParentPay when making the payment.

Please note that if sufficient voluntary contributions are not received towards the cost of the trip, it may have to be cancelled.

Children need to wear their school uniform but will need wellies or walking shoes in case its muddy walking to the village.

The coach will leave school at 9.15am and return by 3.30pm. All pupils will require a packed lunch in a named carrier bag that can then be thrown away afterwards. Please do not send fizzy drinks or sweets. Children should not bring any money with them.

We will need some adult helpers for the trip, so if you are available please can you advise your child's class teacher no later than Tuesday 26th September.
